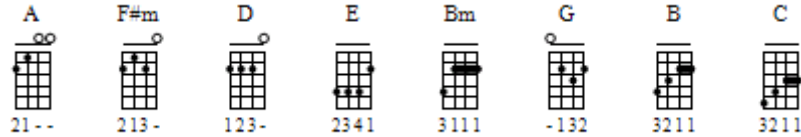


# Reasons Not To Be An Idiot
