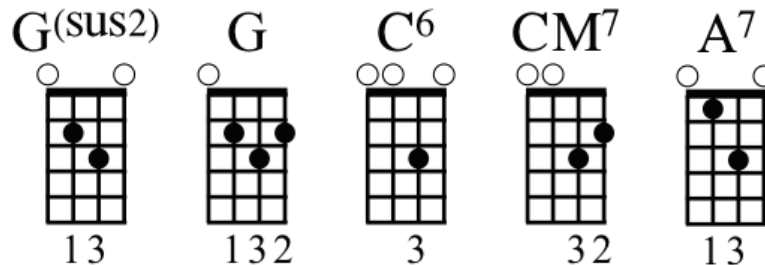


Bigger on the Inside
