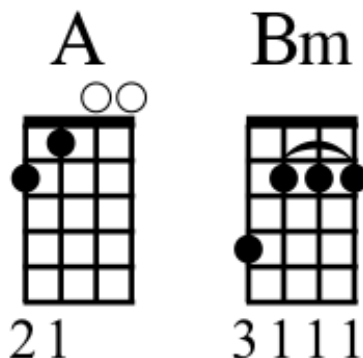


I'd Rather Go Blind
